A RESOLUTION ENDORSING REPEAL OF SB 100 AND THE AUTHORITY OF L.C.D.C.

WHEREAS, the Land Conservation and Development Commission created by the Oregon Legislature's SB 100 is a governmental system outside the electoral process eliminating the power of our citizens' vote; and


WHEREAS, for the first time in United States history an appointed agency (L.C.D.C.) has judicial review of the Ordinances of city and county elected officials, the direct representatives of Oregon's citizens; and


WHEREAS, for the first time in United States history an appointed agency (L.C.D.C.) has legislative power to amend the Ordinances of city and county elected officials, the direct representatives of Oregon's citizens; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Council of the City of Canby, Oregon, do hereby endorse Repeal of SB 100 and the authority of L.C.D.C.; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that legislation by the Oregon State Legislature, as well as by the United States Congress, restore the power of our citizens to vote on all issues affecting their future well-being, including land use issues.
