

RESOLUTION NO. CCVI (206)

A RESOLUTION CALLING A SECOND BUDGET AND TAX LEVY ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the City's annual budget and tax levy measures were defeated at a Budget and Tax Levy Election held in and for the City of Canby on July 28, 1976; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council has reviewed the budget and tax levy measures as previously submitted to the voters and has determined that the budget as approved at the budget hearing on June 28, 1976, and adopted by the Council by Resolution No. CCIII (203) is a minimum budget for this fiscal year, and should be resubmitted to the voters without change but not the question of a serial tax levy for the Police Department. It is therefore hereby,

RESOLVED that the budget approved at the budget hearing on June 28, 1976, and which is now on file in the office of the Canby City Recorder is hereby ratified and confirmed and Resolution No. CCIII (203) adopted by the Council on July 12, 1976, nunc pro tunc July 6, 1976, is hereby RESTATED and for the purpose of a second budget and tax levy election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Second Budget and Tax Levy Election be and is hereby called to be held at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, on Wednesday, August 25, 1976, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of said City, pursuant to ORS 294.305 to 294.520, inclusive, and Article XI, Section 11 of the Oregon Constitution, the question of approving that portion of the City's annual budget for the 1976-77 fiscal tax year which is outside the constitutional 6% limitation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder be and he

hereby is directed to prepare a Notice of said election and to have such Notice published in two successive issues of The Canby Herald, a newspaper printed and published in Canby, Oregon. The first publication of such Notice to be not less than ten (10) days prior to said election; and that at least ten (10) days prior to said election, the City Recorder shall post Notice thereof in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the City. One of such Notices must be posted at the Canby City Hall which is the only polling place.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder be and he hereby is directed to appoint a Receiving Board for said election of four (4) persons and also a Counting Board for said election of four (4) persons; and to notify each of them immediately of their appointment. The Receiving Board as appointed may also act as the Counting Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder be and he hereby is directed to prepare the necessary Ballots for said election, and to furnish the Election Board which he appoints with the necessary official Ballots, poll books and paraphernalia.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon conclusion of said election, the City Recorder certify to the County Clerk and County Assessor of Clackamas County, Oregon, and the Department of Revenue at its office in Salem, Oregon, the tax levy made by Resolution No. CCIII (203) and if approved by the qualified legal voters, and shall file with each of those departments a copy of the Budget as adopted and finally approved.

Adopted by the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof on August 6, 1976.
