RESOLUTION NO. CCVII (287)

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO THE STRIPING OF TRAFFIC LANES ON HIGHWAY 99E AT FOURTH AVENUE BY THE STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT TO PROVIDE LEFT AND RIGHT TURN REFUGE LANES ONTO FOURTH AVENUE AND TO RESTRICT PARKING EAST AND WEST ON BOTH SIDES OF HIGHWAY 99E A DISTANCE OF 700 FEET FROM THE CENTERLINE OF FOURTH AVENUE.

WHEREAS, the Pacific Highway East at its intersection with North Fourth Avenue in the City of Canby is a State Primary Highway No. 1E; and

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Canby City Council, turning movements in the area create a hazard and restrict traffic flow; now therefore,

BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Canby that the State Highway Department be requested to provide adequate striping on 99E and establish right and left turn refuge lanes from 99E onto Fourth Avenue.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Canby restrict all parking on both sides of 99E for a distance of 700 feet east and west from the intersection of the centerlines of Fourth Avenue and Highway 99E.
