## RESOLUTION NO. CCIX (209)

A RESOLUTION CALLING A SECOND BUDGET AND TAX LEVY ELECTION.

WHEREAS, the City's annual budget and tax levy measures

were defeated at a Budget and Tax Levy Election held in and for

the City of Canby on July 28, 1976; and

whereas, the Canby City Council has reviewed the budget and tax levy measures as previously submitted to the voters and has determined that the budget as approved at the budget hearing on June 28, 1976, and adopted by the Council by Resolution No. CCIII (203) is a minimum budget for this fiscal year, and should be resubmitted to the voters without change but not the question of a serial tax levy for the Police Department. It is therefore hereby,

RESOLVED that the budget approved at the budget hearing on June 28, 1976, and which is now on file in the office of the Canby City Recorder is hereby ratified and confirmed and Resolution No. CCIII (203) adopted by the Council on July 12, 1976, nunc pro tunc July 6, 1976, is hereby RESTATED for the purpose of a second budget and tax levy election.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a Second Budget and Tax Levy Election be and is hereby called to be held at the Camby Fire Station (Precinct 123) and the Camby Grade School (Precinct 121, 122 and 124) in Camby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, on Wednesday, September 1, 1976, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of said City, pursuant to ORS 294.305 to 294.520, inclusive, and Article XI, Section 11 of the Oregon Constitution, the question of approving that portion of the City's annual budget for the 1976-77 fiscal tax year which is outside the constitutional 6% limitation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder be and he hereby is directed to prepare a Notice of said election and to have such Notice published in two successive issues of The Canby Herald, a newspaper printed and published in Canby, Oregon. The first publication of such Notice to be not less than ten (10) days prior to said election; and that at least ten (10) days prior to said election, the City Recorder shall post Notice thereof in at least three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City and also at each of the poling places.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clackamas County Elections
Department be requested to conduct said election and the City
Recorder shall furnish that department with the necessary information for preparation of the official ballots.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon conclusion of said election, the City Recorder certify to the County Clerk and County Assessor of Clackamas County, Oregon, and the Department of Revenue at its office in Salem, Oregon, the tax levy made by Resolution No. CCIII (203) if approved by the qualified legal voters, and shall file with each of those departments a copy of the Budget as adopted and finally approved.
