

RESOLUTION NO. CCXIV (214)

A RESOLUTION PROHIBITING PARKING ON HIGHWAY 99E.

WHEREAS, there is an increasing traffic and safety problem on State Highway 99E in the City of Canby, and prohibition of parking in certain areas will tend to alleviate some of the problems and provide for better safety of both pedestrian and vehicular traffic; now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED AND ORDERED by the Canby City Council that:

Section 1: No vehicle shall be parked or left standing on the right-of-way of State Highway 99E for a distance of 400 feet east and west of the centerline of Ivy Street in the City of Canby; and this regulation shall be effective immediately.

Section 2: The City Superintendent of Public Works shall provide and install appropriate signs at proper places on said Highway to provide notice of this regulation.

Section 3: The Canby Police Department is directed to enforce Section 1 of this Order.

Section 4: The Highway Division of the Department of Transportation of the State of Oregon shall be notified of this action by the City Recorder, who shall file any necessary request on behalf of the Council for approval of that agency.
