RESOLUTION NO. CCXXIII (223)

A RESOLUTION ENDORSING A COOPERATIVE LIBRARY SERVICE FOR CLACKAMAS COUNTY; AND PASSAGE OF A LEVY TO FINANCE THE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, Clackamas County currently has no Countywide library system; and

WHEREAS, a comprehensive Countywide library service helps further the educational process, promotes public awareness and provides recreational opportunity for all citizens of Clackamas County; and

WHEREAS, an election is scheduled to be held on Tuesday,
May 17, 1977, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters
of Clackamas County, the question of approving a three-year library
serial levy for the purposes of re-establishing the bookmobile van
service, inter-library loans, union catalogue and to establish a
uniform registration system for all library users and to eliminate
borrowers' fees; and

WHEREAS, approval of said levy will provide equalization grant monies to the cities in Clackamas County, thereby creating an equitable arrangement of library service funding for both those people residing within city limits and those residing in the unincorporated areas of Clackamas County.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Canby endorses the concept of a cooperative library service as being in the best interests of the City residents; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council supports passage of the levy to be submitted at the election to be held on Tuesday, May 17, 1977, and urges all qualified electors to vote in said election.
