## RESOLUTION NO. CCXXIV (224)

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING BUDGET AND CALLING A BUDGET AND TAX LEVY ELECTION.

- 1. BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Canby, a municipal corporation of Clackamas County, State of Oregon, hereby adopts the budget approved at the budget hearing on May 16, 1977, and which is now on file in the office of the Canby City Recorder.
- 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a budget and tax levy election be and is hereby called to be held at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, on Wednesday, June 1, 1977 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of said City, pursuant to ORS 294.305 to 294.565, inclusive, and Article XI, Section 11 of the Oregon Constitution, the question of approving that portion of the City's annual budget for the 1977-78 fiscal tax year which is outside the constitutional 6% limitation.
- 3. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Canby City Council hereby levies the taxes provided for in the budget adopted in Paragraph 1 of this Resolution in the aggregate amount of \$432,991. and providing that the budget and tax levy is approved by the qualified legal voters of the City of Canby at the election which is hereby called for such purpose. If the budget and tax levy is approved by the voters, these taxes are hereby levied upon all taxable property within the City of Canby as of 1:00 a.m. January 1, 1977.
- 4. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the amounts for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1977, for the purposes shown below are hereby appropriated as follows but subject, however, to approval thereof by the qualified legal voters:

The total operational tax levy for 1977-78 is \$432,991, of which \$125,359 is inside the 6% limitation and \$307,632 is outside the 6% limitation.

- 5. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Recorder be and he hereby is directed to prepare a Notice of said election and to have such Notice published in two or more successive issues of The Canby Herald, a newspaper printed and published in Canby, Oregon. The first publication of such Notice to be not less than ten (10) days prior to said election; and that at least ten (10) days prior to said election, the City Recorder shall post Notice thereof in at least three (3) conspicuous places in the City. One of such Notices must be posted at the Canby City Hall which is the only polling place.
- 6. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Recorder prepare the form of the official ballot and that the Clackamas County Elections Department appoint a Chairman and Clerks of an election board to conduct said election in accordance with the election laws of the State of Oregon, and furnish said board prior to 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 1, 1977, ballots, ballot boxes and all necessary paraphernalia and election supplies as may be required for said election; and that upon the conclusion of the election the results thereof be certified to the Canby City Council.

7. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon certification of the election results the City Recorder certify to the County Clerk and County Assessor of Clackamas County, Oregon, and the Department of Revenue at its office in Salem, Oregon, the tax levy made by this Resolution and as approved by the qualified legal voters, and shall file with each of those departments a copy of the Budget as adopted and finally approved.
