

RESOLUTION CCXXVI (226)

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING THE USES OF WATER STOCKED WITH FISH WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ANY CANBY CITY PARK.


WHEREAS, in accordance with the authority contained in Canby City Ordinance No. 525 adopted by the Canby City Council on December 2, 1969, and relating to the use of waters stocked with fish by the City of Canby, the Canby City Council has determined that it is necessary to adopt additional rules and regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Canby City Council that all waters stocked with fish within the boundaries of any Canby City Park shall be used for angling purposes only.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there shall be no swimming, wading, boating, canoeing, rafting, sailing or similar type activity in waters stocked with fish within the boundaries of any Canby City Park.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing regulations be published in the Canby Herald once a week for two (2) successive publications commencing with the first publication on Wednesday, the \_\_\_\_ day of June, 1977.
