

RESOLUTION NO. CCXXVII (227)


A RESOLUTION RESCINDING COUNCIL ACTION BY RESOLUTION NO. CCXXVI (226) RELATING TO THE USES OF WATER STOCKED WITH FISH WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF ANY CANBY CITY PARK.

WHEREAS, council Resolution No. CCXXVI (226) adopted June 6, 1977 restricted the uses of water stocked with fish within the boundaries of any Canby City Park in accordance with the authority contained in Canby city Ordinance No. 525; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 525 had previously been repealed by Ordinance No. 625. It is therefore hereby,


RESOLVED that the action of the council taken by Resolution No. CCXXVI (226) restricting the uses of water stocked with fish within the boundaries of any Canby city park is hereby rescinded.

Adopted by the Canby City Council at a special meeting thereof on June 15, 1977.
