

RESOLUTION NO. CCXXXI (231)

A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING ELIGIBILITY FOR STATE CIGARETTE TAX REVENUE, STATE HIGHWAY FUND ALLOCATIONS AND STATE LIQUOR REVENUE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

Section 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Fire protection
- (3) Street construction, maintenance and lighting
- (4) Sanitary sewers
- (5) Storm sewers
- (6) Planning, zoning and subdivision control
- (7) One or more utility services


WHEREAS, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting the state officer responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Canby, Oregon, hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:

Service

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Fire protection (Performed by contract with Canby Rural Fire District)
- (3) Street construction, maintenance and lighting
- (4) Sanitary sewers
- (5) Storm sewers
- (6) Planning, zoning and subdivision control
- (7) Electric utility services furnished by Canby Utility Board
