

ORDINANCE NO. 219

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 5, RELATING TO INSTALLATION PERMITS, OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 69 OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, ENACTED THE 22ND DAY OF MARCH, 1955, PROVIDING FOR INCREASED PERMIT FEES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The city of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 5, relating to Installation Permits, of Ordinance Number 69 of the city of Brookings, enacted the 22nd day of March, 1955, shall be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 5. Installation Permits. No plumbing installations or alterations or addition to existing plumbing within the city of Brookings, as plumbing is defined in the statutes of the state of Oregon, shall be made without a permit therefor first being secured from the building inspector of the city of Brookings, Oregon. Application for such permit, describing the work to be done accompanied by such plans, specifications and schedules as may be to determine whether the installation will be in conformity with the requirements of this ordinance, shall be filed by all applicants with the building inspector, who shall issue a permit for such installations or work if the applicant has complied with all of the provisions of this ordinance and if the fees hereinafter provided are paid at the time of the filing of the application. No permit shall allow any deviation from the installation or work so described without the written approval of the building inspector nor shall the issuance of any such permit be taken as permission to violate any of the provisions of this ordinance. Before any such permit is granted for the installation or altering of any plumbing work in the city of Brookings, the person, firm or corporation making application for such work shall pay, in advance, to the building inspector a fee as follows:

One fixture	\$5.00
Each additional fixture	\$1.00

Section 2. It is hereby determined that it is in the interest of public welfare, peace and safety that immediate action be taken; now, therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the council and signing of the mayor.

The foregoing ordinance was duly adopted by the Council of the city of Brookings and signed by the Mayor this 11th day of August, 1970.
