

ORDINANCE NO. 214

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 6, 7 AND 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 145 ENACTED MAY 10, 1960 PROVIDING FOR INCREASED LICENSE FEES AND DECLARING THE SAME TO BE AN EMERGENCY.

The city of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 145 enacted the 10th day of May, 1960 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6. Annual Fees. There is hereby levied and imposed upon each business in the city of Brookings a license tax for such business as herein provided. The license tax for each such business for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1970, and terminating June 30, 1971, and for each such fiscal year thereafter shall be the sum of \$35.00. If the full license tax has not been paid by August 31, the \$35.00 license tax plus 10 percent shall be paid. The payment of the tax and issuance of a license for the conduct of any business prohibited by law or ordinance of the city of Brookings shall not be deemed to be a permit or license of the city of Brookings for the conduct of any such business or to waive any provision of law or ordinance now or hereafter enacted regulating or prohibiting the conduct of any such business, or a part thereof. In the event the city of Brookings shall be prevented or prohibited by law from licensing and taxing any business, this ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect as to all other businesses or branches of business provided to be licensed. Any such prohibition or prevention now or hereafter in effect shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as to any other business.
