

ORDINANCE NO. 323

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PORTIONS OF THE CRIMINAL CODE OF OREGON, PORTIONS OF THE OREGON LIQUOR CONTROL LAWS, AND PORTIONS OF THE OREGON MOTOR VEHICLE CODE.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Adoption of Portions of the Criminal Code of Oregon, Portions of the Oregon Liquor Control Laws, and Portions of the Motor Vehicle Code of Oregon. The following enumerated portions of the Criminal Code of Oregon, portions of the Oregon Liquor Control Laws, and portions of the Motor Vehicle Code of Oregon, together with all acts and amendments now or hereafter enacted, are hereby adopted by reference and made a part of this ordinance:



Section 2. Severability. If any provision, or provisions of this ordinance shall be declared void and/or unconstitutional, it is hereby provided that all other parts of the same which are not expressly held to be void, and/or unconstitutional, shall be and continue in full force and effect.

Section 3. Repeal. The following sections of Ordinance No. 13 relating to general offenses, passed November 27, 1951, as amended by Ordinance No's 70,112,147, 150 and 184, are hereby repealed:

Section 1, 2, 8, 9, 11, 14, 16, 17, 23, 25, 27, 31, 32, 33, 36, 43, 52, 53, 54, 57, 58, 59, 60, 61, 63, 77, 78, 87, 88, 89, 105 and 106. The following sections of Ordinance No. 157 relating to traffic control, passed January 10, 1961 as amended by Ordinance No. 178, are hereby repealed: Section 6, 7, 8, 9, 18, 19, 20, 25, 26, 27, 30, 48, 49, 52, 56 and 57.
