

ORDINANCE NO. 320

AN ORDINANCE SETTING PROCEDURES FOR JURY TRIALS; ADOPTING STATE STATUTE AS CITY ORDINANCES; REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 136.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Common Council of the City of Brookings as follows:

(1) All jury trials for violations of City of Brookings ordinances shall be conducted in accordance with the requirements of State law and the requirements of the City of Brookings Charter.


(2) The following section of the Oregon Revised Statutes as they presently exist or are later amended or changed are hereby adopted as ordinances of the City of Brookings. Penalties upon conviction shall be the same as set out in the Oregon Revised Statutes.

(3) Ordinance No. 136 is hereby repealed.


