

ORDINANCE NO. 316

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, TO SUBMIT TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION WHETHER OR NOT THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY SHOULD BE AUTHORIZED TO LEVY A TAX OF \$147,043.59 IN EXCESS OF THE 6% LIMITATION IMPOSED BY ARTICLE XI, SECTION 11, OF THE OREGON CONSTITUTION FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1979-80; CALLING AND MAKING PROVISION FOR SUCH ELECTION; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.A Special Election shall be held within the City of Brookings, Oregon on the 18th day of September, 1979. At said Special Election, the following proposition or question shall be submitted to the legal voters of said City for their approval or rejection:

For the fiscal year 1979-80 shall the Council of the City of Brookings, in Curry County, Oregon, be authorized to levy a tax of \$147,043.59 in excess of the 6% limitation imposed by Article XI, Section 11, of the Oregon Constitution, for the purpose of providing funds with which to properly administer the financial affairs of the City of Brookings?

Section 2. The polling place for said election for each of the voting precincts in the City shall be the City Hall, unless otherwise designated by the County Clerk, in the City of Brookings and said poll shall be open between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m. on said election day.

Section 3. The ballots of said election shall be in substantially the following form:

For Special Election in the City of Brookings, Oregon to be held on September 18, 1979.

The total amount of money to be raised by the proposed levy is \$265,471.00. If this measure is approved, the operating budget to be financed by local taxes for the tax years 1979-80 will be \$31,147.00 greater than the operating budget financed by local taxes for the preceding year.

The additional funds will be utilized to balance the General Fund Budget prepared by the Budget Committee.

Section 4. The City Recorder is hereby instructed to give notice of said election by posting copies thereof as follows: One in the City Hall, one in three public and conspicuous places in each of the City's voting precincts at least ten days prior to said election and by publishing said notice in the Curry Coastal Pilot, a newspaper printed and published within the corporate limits of the City of Brookings, once a week for two weeks, immediately prior to the date of the said election. Said notice shall contain the proposal, ballot title and number in full, together with the time and place that said election should be held.

Section 5. The Recorder is hereby directed to submit this information to the Curry County Clerk by August 14, 1979 to prepare all necessary ballots and supplies for said election.


Section 6. The Council hereby finds that it is necessary to levy a tax for the fiscal year 1979-80 in excess of the 6% constitutional limitation in order to properly administer the City's affairs during such fiscal year; and that it is necessary to secure a favorable vote of the legal voters of said City in order to authorize the Council to levy such extra tax, and that such vote of the people cannot be secured soon enough to enable a tax levy to be made within the time provided by law without making this an emergency ordinance; and that is hereby declared necessary for the peace, health, and safety of the City of Brookings, Oregon, and its inhabitants that this Ordinance be in full force and effect immediately; and on account thereof, the Council hereby declares an emergency to exist, and that this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by the Council and its approval by the Mayor.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed by the Council of the City of Brookings, and signed by the Mayor on this 17th day of July, 1979.
