

ORDINANCE NO. 315

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE CONSUMPTION AND POSSESSION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON PUBLIC PREMISES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to drink, consume, transport, carry, or possess any alcoholic liquor, except in the original package with the seal unbroken, on any public premises, except as permitted in Section 4 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2. The term alcoholic liquor, as used in this Ordinance, shall be construed to mean and include any liquid intended for human consumption containing more than one half of one percent by volume of alcohol.

SECTION 3. For the purpose of this Ordinance, public premises shall include city parks, city buildings, city parking lots, and other premises under the control of the city, but shall not include public highways.

SECTION 4. Upon written application to the Common Council of the City of Brookings, setting forth the time, the purpose, the location, the alcoholic beverages involved, and the group or organization involved, the Council may grant temporary permits permitting the possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages on public premises. Such permits shall be for a specific period of time, shall contain such conditions as the Council deems appropriate, and shall be non-transferable.

SECTION 5. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$500 or by imprisonment not exceeding 60 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.


SECTION 6. The Common Council of the City of Brookings hereby deems that the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings requires that this Ordinance be immediately adopted, and an emergency is therefore declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.
