

ORDINANCE NO. 314

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 157, OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, PERTAINING TO TRAFFIC AND PARKING CODE FOR MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED By the Council of the City of Brookings, as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF NEW CHAPTER

Section 1 of Ordinance 157 of the City of Brookings is amended to include the adoption by reference and making a part thereof Chapters 484 and 487, of Oregon Revised Statutes, as they appear on the date of adoption of this Ordinance. Any amendment or revision of said chapters, Section or part by the Oregon Legislature, shall be adopted by reference and made a part of this Ordinance at the effective date of said amendment or revision in the Oregon Revised Statutes, and shall have full force and effect as a part of this Ordinance, without further action by the City Council. Except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning, the definitions outlined in Chapters 484 and 487 shall apply to all sections of Ordinance 157. All parts of Section 1 inconsistent with this amendment are hereby repealed.

SECTION 2. SEVERABILITY CLAUSE


If any provision, or provisions of this Ordinance shall be declared void and/or unconstitutional, it is hereby provided that all other parts of the same which are not expressly held to be void, and/or unconstitutional, shall be and continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE

The Common Council of the City of Brookings hereby deems that the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings requires that this Ordinance be immediately adopted, and an emergency is therefore declared to exist and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage.


