

ORDINANCE NO. 307

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CERTAIN RULES AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING
THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE CITY MANAGER

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, The City Council desires the administrative branch of City government to function with optimum efficiency and economy, and

WHEREAS, the City Council is the legislative and official policy making body of the government of the City, and


WHEREAS, the City Manager is the Chief Administrative Officer of the government of the City under the policy direction and control of the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has general supervision and control over appointive City Officers and Employees and their work, and


WHEREAS, it is the duty of the City Manager to supervise the City departments to the end obtaining the utmost efficiency in each of them,

THEREFORE, except for purposes of inquiry, the Mayor, the Council or its members shall deal with the Administrative services under the jurisdiction of the City Manager solely through the City Manager and shall not give orders to any subordinate of the City Manager either publicly or privately.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed by the Council of the City of Brookings and signed by the Mayor on this 11th day of December, 1978.
