

ORDINANCE NO. 238

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 235
OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS PROVIDING FOR
THE REMOVAL OF AUTHORIZATION FOR THE USE
OF PROCEEDS OF A \$2,000,000 WATER BOND
ISSUE FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAINTAINING THE
WATER SYSTEM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1:

Ordinance No. 235 of the City of Brookings, Oregon,
adopted on the 8th day of May, 1973, is hereby amended as follows:


All references contained in said Ordinance in its
entirety to the maintaining by the City of Brookings of the water
system with bond proceeds shall be, and they are hereby deleted.

The remainder of the subject ordinance shall remain in
full force and effect.

Section 2:

The Council hereby finds that the present existing
conditions relating to water supply in the City creates a need
for immediate action. That it is, therefore, necessary for the
peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and its
inhabitants that this Ordinance be in full force and effect
immediately upon its passage by the Council and approval by
the Mayor. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist, and
this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately
upon its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly passed by the
Council and signed by the Mayor this 12th day of June 1973.
