

ORDINANCE NO. 92-O-146.A

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 60-O-146, SECTION 10, SUBSECTION A, OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance Identified. This ordinance amends Ordinance No. 60-O-146, enacted May 10, 1960, and entitled, "An ordinance providing for public improvements, prescribing the methods and procedures for making public improvements, for levying and collecting special assessments therefor, and for the creation and enforcement of assessment liens; repealing Ordinances No. 53-O-043, 53-O-048 and 56-O-099 and declaring an emergency."

Section 2. Amendment to Section 10, Subsection A. Section 10, Subsection A of Ordinance No. 60-O-146 is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 10. Lien recording - Collection of assessments.

A. Upon the passage of the ordinance making the assessment, as provided in Section 7 above, the recorder shall immediately enter in the docket of city liens a statement of the respective amounts assessed upon each particular lot or parcel of land with the names of the record owners thereof. Upon entry in such lien docket, the amount so entered shall be a lien and charge upon the respective lots, tracts, and parcels of land against which the same are placed, and shall be due and payable within 30 days after the date of entry provided by law. Interest shall be charged at the rate determined by the city council upon its acceptance of applications for installment payments on all such assessments and

amounts not paid within 30 days from the date of such entry, and the interest shall run from the day of entry if not paid within 30 days.

Section 3. Emergency clause. It is hereby determined that it is in the interest of the public welfare, peace and safety of the city of Brookings that this ordinance be immediately adopted and therefore an emergency is declared to exist, and that this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its' passage.


