

ORDINANCE NO. 150

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 13 BY THE ADDITION OF SECTION 104 RELATING TO CARD GAMES, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 29, PASSED SEPTEMBER 9, 1952.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 13, passed December 27, 1951, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 104. Card Games. No person may engage or participate in any type of card game in a public place between 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m. The owner or manager of a card table may not permit his facilities to be used by a person to engage or participate in playing card games in a public place between 1:00 a.m. and 8:00 a.m."

Section 2. Ordinance No. 29, passed September 9, 1952, relating to card games, is repealed.
