

ORDINANCE NO. 151

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 113, PASSED MARCH 11, 1958.

The City of Brookings ordains as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 113, passed March 11, 1958, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1.

(1) The obstruction of sidewalks by permitting shade trees, ornamental trees or hedges to grow in such a manner that the clear space over the sidewalk shall be less than seven feet free of branches or foliage for the full width of such walk shall constitute a nuisance and be abated in the manner herein prescribed.

(2) Trees, shrubs or hedges and signs, fences or other objects located along a street which obstruct a driver's view of traffic, control signs or signals, and create a traffic hazard, shall constitute a nuisance and shall be abated in the manner herein prescribed."
