

ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF THE 15' ALLEY WHICH BISECTS BLOCKS 19 AND 27, AS SHOWN ON PLAT NO. 1, BROOKINGS, OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AS SAID ALLEY IS SET FORTH AND DESCRIBED IN SAID PLAT NO. 1, OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY. forward

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The Council, having made its own motion to vacate the hereinafter described portion of the unnamed alley, situate in Blocks 19 and 27, of the City of Brookings, and having directed the giving of the notice of the vacation thereof as required by law and having held the public hearing called for in said notice, finds and hereby makes its determination a matter of record that the proceedings for the vacation of the said portion of said alley were had upon the Council's own motion and upon the petition of Elmer Bankus, Edward L. Thornton and Neva V. Thornton, Lorings Sales & Service, Inc. by Alden M. Loring, President, and Oregon State Board of Forestry by D. S. Phipps, State Forester, who own property adjacent to and which shall be affected by the said vacation of said alley, and further, that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of the said portion of said alley; that the best interest and welfare of the public will be served by such vacation; and that said vacation should be affected.

SECTION 2: That portion of the (15') foot alley bisecting Blocks 19 and 27, Plat No. 1, Brookings (recorded in Book 1 at Page 5, Plat records of Curry County, Oregon) Between the intersection of said alley with the Easterly side of Fern Avenue, and the intersection of said alley with the westerly side of Alder Street, EXCEPT that portion thereof located in Oak Street;

EXCEPT that portion lying Northerly of Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4, Block 19, in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, SHALL BE, and hereby is, declared vacated absolutely, leaving the public with no right or interest whatsoever therein and this portion of said vacated unnamed alley shall revert back to the abutting property owners, as provided by law.

SECTION 3: That portion of the unnamed alley in this ordinance vacated shall be excluded from the approved system and plan of streets and alleys of the City of Brookings and from the official map thereof and the said map shall be amended to show said exclusion.

SECTION 4: WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the vacation of said alley be effected as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist

in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon all of its readings at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approved by the Mayor.
