

ORDINANCE NO. 174

AN ORDINANCE DEDICATING CERTAIN PROPERTY AS A PUBLIC STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The following described property in the City of Brookings is hereby dedicated to the use of the public forever for street purposes. The property is more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point which is East 714.98 feet from the interior quarter section corner of Section 6, Township 41 South, Range 13 West of the Willamette Meridian, Curry County, Oregon; run thence North 50 feet; thence East 222 feet, more or less; thence South 50 feet; thence West 222 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that the status of this property as a street be definitely determined as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon its final passage at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
