

ORDINANCE NO. 175

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 8 OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS BY ADDING SECTION 7 THERETO TO PROVIDE FOR A MUNICIPAL JUDGE PRO TEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 8 of the City of Brookings, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on October 23, 1951, is hereby amended by the addition of Section 7, which shall read as follows:

"Section 7: The office of Municipal Judge Pro-Tem is hereby created. The Municipal Judge Pro-Tem shall be appointed in the same manner as the Municipal Judge. He shall serve as Municipal Judge Pro-Tem when the Municipal Judge is absent from the City, incapacitated or otherwise unable to discharge the duties of Municipal Judge. When occupying the office of Municipal Judge, the Municipal Judge Pro-Tem shall have all the powers and authority of the Municipal Judge."

Section 2: Whereas, there is now no provision for the conduct and operation of the Municipal Court in the absence of the Municipal Judge, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon all of its readings at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
