

ORDINANCE NO. 176

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE BOUNDARIES OF CERTAIN ZONES IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, HERETOFORE ESTABLISHED BY ORDINANCE NO. 19 ADOPTED APRIL 22, 1952, AND THE VARIOUS AMENDMENTS THEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The following described real property located in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, the same having never been formally zoned of record, is hereby zoned as C-1 (Tourist-Commercial):

Lots 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27 of Woodland Park Addition to the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, filed in Plat Book No. 1 at Page 37 of the Official Record of Town Plats of Curry County, Oregon.


Section 2: Ordinance No. 19, adopted April 22, 1952, and the amendments thereof and the zone descriptions therein given, are hereby amended to reflect the zone change made in this ordinance. The zone classification of the above described property as made in this ordinance and above set forth shall be shown and delineated on that certain map entitled "Zoning Map of the City of Brookings, Oregon" on file in the office of the City Recorder, City Hall, Brookings, Oregon.

Section 3: WHEREAS, the above described property is now unzoned and not subject to zoning control and the Council considered the matter at its December 10, 1963 meeting and the zoning of said property should be completed without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon all of its readings and final passage at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
