

ORDINANCE NO. 182

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 77 AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 164, ADOPTING THE 1964 EDITION OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 1 of Ordinance No. 77 adopting the Uniform Building Code for the City of Brookings, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on August 23, 1955, as amended by Ordinance No. 164, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on December 20, 1961, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 1: That certain document, three copies of which are on file in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Brookings, Oregon, being marked and designated as 'Uniform Building Code, 1964 Edition, Volume 1', published by the Pacific Coast Building Officials Conference, shall constitute, and is hereby adopted as, the building code of the City of Brookings, and wherever the words 'Uniform Building Code' appear in this ordinance they refer to said 1964 edition herein designated and described."

WHEREAS, the 1961 Uniform Building Code is now in effect in the City of Brookings and it is necessary and desirable that the City's building code be up-dated immediately and such change be made immediately effective, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon all of its readings at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
