

ORDINANCE NO. 188

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 13 AND 14 OF ORDINANCE NO. 116, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Sections 13 and 14 of Ordinance No. 116, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor August 12, 1958, as amended by Ordinance No. 137, passed September 8, 1959, are hereby amended so as to read as follows:

"Section 13: In the event that the owner or occupant of any real property which has not been assessed for the construction of a sanitary sewer shall desire to have the building on such real property connected with the sanitary sewer system of the City of Brookings, he shall make a written application to the City Recorder for such connection describing the property to be served by a sufficient legal description. At the time of filing the written application, and before the connection is made, the applicant shall pay the sum of \$500.00, plus the sum of not less than \$75.00 toward the cost of constructing a lateral from the main sanitary sewer to the adjacent property line. The portion of the cost of constructing such lateral not paid by the applicant shall be paid by the City. The cost of connecting the private line to the sewer lateral and the construction of the private line to the sewer lateral shall be paid by the applicant. Only a single-family dwelling on a single residential lot may be connected to the sanitary sewer under this section.

"No application shall be received for and no connection made to any property or the dwelling thereon which is in a subdivision which is not within the boundaries of an organized sanitary sewer assessment district. All lots in any subdivision shall be provided with sanitary sewer service

only by and through the formation of a sanitary sewer assessment district, as provided in Ordinance No. 146."

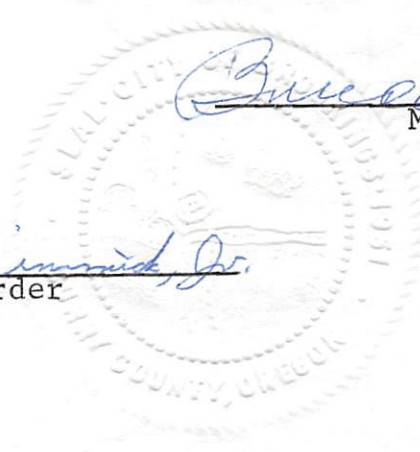
"Section 14: Each \$500.00 connection fee shall allow for the connection of only one single family dwelling on one residential lot to the public sanitary sewer, as herein provided. In addition, after such connection has been made no other connections with other properties or buildings shall be made, either to the private line or the sewer lateral installed under said application. If such connection is made in violation of this provision, the City may, at its option, terminate the connection and block the line so that it shall no longer be served by the public sanitary sewer."

"In the event any of the fees or charges provided by the preceding Section 13 and this Section 14 are not made promptly when due, the City Recorder is authorized to enter the amount of such charges immediately in the docket of city liens as a lien against the real property described in the application for the sanitary sewer connection."

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that a more adequate and realistic charge be made for sanitary sewer connections as herein provided and the construction of the lateral, and to limit more definitely the property and type of building which may be thus connected to the sanitary sewer, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon its final passage at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
