

ORDINANCE NO. 197

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE ON SIGNS AS SET FORTH IN THE 1967 EDITION TO SAID CODE.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 169 prohibiting Commercial outdoor advertising type sign boards and billboards and providing penalties for violation thereof, passed by the City Council and approved by the Mayor September 12, 1962, is hereby repealed.

Section 2: WHEREAS, the 1967 Uniform Building Code is now in effect in the City of Brookings and it is necessary and desirable that the City's sign code be updated, there is hereby adopted the Uniform Building Code on Signs as set forth in Volume V of the 1967 edition to said Building Code and an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon all of its readings at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
