

ORDINANCE NO. 137

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 116 OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS BY PROVIDING FEES AND CHARGES TO BE PAID BY AN OWNER DESIRING TO CONNECT HIS PROPERTY WITH A SANITARY SEWER, WHICH PROPERTY HAS NOT BEEN ASSESSED FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER, PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 116 of the City of Brookings, passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on August 12, 1958, is hereby amended by the addition of a new and additional sections to be known as Sections ~~13~~¹⁴ and 15, reading as follows:

"Section 13: In the event that the owner or occupant of any real property which has not been assessed for the construction of a sanitary sewer shall desire to have a connection with the sanitary sewer system of the City of Brookings, he shall make a written application to the City Recorder for such connection stating the property to be served by sufficient description and the number of buildings on the property to be served by the sewer. At the time of filing the written application and before the connection is made he shall pay the sum of \$300.00, plus the sum of \$75.00 toward the cost of constructing a lateral from the main sanitary sewer to the adjacent property line, which lateral shall be constructed by the City at its expense. The cost of connecting the private line to the lateral and the construction of the private line to the lateral shall be paid by the applicant."

"Section 14: Each \$300.00 connection fee shall allow for the connection of only one property and one building to the public sanitary sewer, as herein provided. In addition, after such connection has been made no other connections with other properties or buildings shall be made, either to the private line or the lateral installed under said application.


If such connection is made in violation of this provision, the City may, at its option, terminate the connection and block the line so that it shall no longer be served by the public sanitary sewer."

"Section 15: Any person violating any provision of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof in the Municipal Court, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00 or imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, and each day that such violation shall continue shall constitute a separate offense."

WHEREAS, there is no provision for fees and charges for connection of property with a sanitary sewer where the property has not been assessed for the construction of a sewer and it is necessary that such provision should be made without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be placed upon all of its readings and passed at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council and approval by the Mayor.
