

ORDINANCE NO. 140

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 2 AND 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 31, APPROVED SEPTEMBER 24, 1952, PROVIDING FOR ELECTION PROCEDURES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 31 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. Nominating petitions must be filed with the recorder not less than 75 days before the day of a general election or not less than 30 days before the day of a special election. A person nominated shall file his written acceptance of the nomination with the recorder not less than 70 days before the day of a general election or not less than 25 days before the day of a special election. In the absence of such acceptance, the name of the candidate shall not appear on the ballot. The recorder shall prepare and have printed the necessary ballots for the special election. In any election the recorder shall certify information required by the county clerk of Curry County in conformity with the time limits established by the laws of this state."

Section 2. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 31 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. When city measures are to be voted upon, the recorder shall prepare the official ballot with ballot titles and numbers for the various measures. The recorder shall use the ballot title prepared by the city attorney and shall have the numbers and ballot title printed upon the official ballot. The affirmative of the first measure shall be numbered 51 and the negative 52 in numerals and succeeding measures shall be numbered consecutively 53, 54, etc., in the same manner. In a general election the recorder shall certify the official ballot for city measures to the county clerk in conformity with the time limits established by the laws of this state."

Section 3. Whereas, the ordinances of the city of Brookings are being compiled, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this

ordinance may be introduced, read and placed upon its final passage at any one meeting of the council and shall be in force after its passage and approval by the mayor.
