

ORDINANCE NO. 142

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 22 AND 24 OF ORDINANCE NO. 58, APPROVED JUNE 9, 1954, PROVIDING FOR INITIATIVE AND REFERENDUM PROCEDURE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 22 of Ordinance No. 58 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 22. Notice of Election.

I. Publishing and posting. The recorder, pursuant to directions from the council, shall give at least 10 days notice of each regular or special election by posting a notice thereof in a conspicuous place in the city hall and in three public places in each voting precinct of the city and by publishing the notice once each week, for two weeks immediately preceding the election in a newspaper of general circulation in the city.

II. Form. The form of the notices shall be as follows:

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

On _____, 19____, in the city of Brookings, Oregon, from _____ a.m. until _____ p.m. a special election will be held at which the following will be submitted to the voters for their approval _____

(On above line insert number and ballot title of each measure to be voted upon at said election.)

The polling places for the election will be as follows:

Section 2. Section 24 of Ordinance No. 58 is amended to read as follows:

"Section 24. Furnishing Information of Measure to County Clerk. When a measure is to be voted upon at a general election,

the recorder shall furnish the clerk of Curry County a certified copy of the ballot title and number of the measure to be voted upon at the election in conformity with the time limits established by the laws of this state."

Section 3. Whereas, the ordinances of the city of Brookings are being compiled, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance may be introduced, read and placed upon its final passage at any one meeting of the council and shall be in force after its passage and approval by the mayor.
