

**ORDINANCE NO. 90-O-115.A**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 58-O-115, ENACTED JUNE 10, 1958, AND ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE LOCATION, CONSTRUCTION, MAINTENANCE, SANITATION, AND CONDUCT OF TRAILER PARKS IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 52-O-018", BY AMENDING SECTION 15 PROVIDING FOR TEMPORARY USE OF A TRAILER COACH FOR SLEEPING PURPOSES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

- Section 1. Amendment to Ordinance No. 58-O-115, Section 15.**  
**Section 2. Emergency clause.**

**The city of Brookings ordains as follows:**

**Section 1. Amendment to Ordinance No. 58-O-115, Section 15. Section 15 of Ordinance No. 58-O-115 is amended to read in full as follows:**

**Section 15. It is unlawful to use a trailer coach for living purposes within the City of Brookings except when parked within a licensed trailer park. A trailer coach may be used for temporary sleeping purposes within the City of Brookings provided as follows:**

- A. That the trailer coach is located entirely on private property;**
- B. That no connection may be made to the City's water or sewer system; and**
- C. That the period of use shall not exceed seven (7) days out of any calendar year.**

**Section 2.      Emergency clause.** Based upon current uses of trailer coaches in violation of existing ordinances and a need for regulation, the City's health and welfare is affected. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage by the Council and signing by the Mayor.


