**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 51-O-004, ENACTED OCTOBER 23, 1951, AND ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF CITY ATTORNEY; PRESCRIBING THE QUALIFICATIONS THEREFOR; PRESCRIBING THE JURISDICTION AND DUTIES THEREOF; PROVIDING THE COMPENSATION THEREFOR; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY." BY AMENDING SECTION 4.F., POWERS AND DUTIES OF CITY ATTORNEY.**

**The City of Brookings ordains as follows:**

**Section 1. Amendment to Ordinance No. 51-O-004, Section 4.F.  
Ordinance No. 51-O-004, Subsection F. is hereby amended to read as follows:**

**F. The City Attorney, either in person or by deputy, shall attend all regular monthly meetings of the Council unless excused by the Mayor and the Council and shall attend all other special meetings, work study sessions and events as may be directed by the City Manager, Mayor or the Council.**

**Section 2. Severability. If any provision, part or parts of this ordinance shall be held to be unconstitutional, invalid, or otherwise inoperative, such invalidity shall not affect other provisions hereof which can be given effect without the invalid provision, the remainder hereof shall remain in full force and effect as a valid and subsisting ordinance until repealed and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.**
