ORDINANCE NO. 9

AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF CITY ENGINEER, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF THE CITY ENGINEER, PROVIDING FOR THE DUTIES THEREOF, PRESCRIBING THE QUALIFICATIONS THEREFOR, PRESCRIBING THE COMPENSATION THEREFOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby created the office of City Engineer.

Section 2. No person shall hold the office of City Engineer who is not either a professional engineer, duly licensed and registered as such by the State of Oregon, or a professional land surveyor, duly licensed and registered as such by the State of Oregon.

Section 3. The City Engineer shall be appointed by the Council and shall hold office during the pleasure of the Council.

Section 4. The City Engineer shall perform such engineering duties as the Council may, from time to time, direct.

Section 5. The City Engineer shall receive as compensation for his services such remuneration as the Council shall determine from time to time.

Section 6. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
