

ORDINANCE NO. 16

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING AND ADOPTING THE CURRY COUNTY JAIL AND THE COOS COUNTY JAIL AS THE CITY JAIL, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE OR ANY POLICE OFFICER OF THE BUREAU OF POLICE TO TRANSPORT PRISONERS TO AND FROM SAID JAIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

Section 1. The Curry County jail situated at Gold Beach, Curry County, Oregon, and the Coos County jail situated at Coquille, Coos County, Oregon, are hereby designated and adopted as the City jail of the City of Brookings within the meaning of all ordinances of the City of Brookings.

Section 2. The Chief of Police or any police officer of the Bureau of Police is hereby authorized and directed to transport any prisoner accused or convicted of violating any ordinance of the City of Brookings from the City of Brookings to the Curry County jail at Gold Beach, Oregon, and/or the Coos County jail at Coquille, Oregon, and from the Curry County jail at Gold Beach, Oregon, and/or the Coos County jail at Coquille, Oregon, to the City of Brookings at such time and by such modes of transportation as are appropriate to the particular situation.

Section 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
