ORDINANCE NO. 16 .

AN ORDINANCE RESCINDING ORDINANCE NO. 16, AND RE-ENACTING THE SAME FOR THE PURPOSE OF ESTABLISHING THE LOCATION OF THE CITY JAIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 16 of the City Of Brookings is hereby rescinded.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 16 of the City of Brookings is hereby enacted for the purpose of designating and creating a City Jail and establishing the location thereof.

SECTION 3. The City Jail of the City of Brookings shall be located in the City Hall Building of the City of Brookings and that space contained within the said City Hall wherein a jail has been constructed and is now being used and operated as a jail, is hereby named, designated and adopted as the City Jail of the City of Brookings.

SECTION 4. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
