

ORDINANCE NO: 66

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF FIR STREET AND A PORTION OF AN ALLEY LOCATED WITHIN BLOCK 17 OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS AS SAID STREET AND ALLEY ARE SET FORTH AND DESCRIBED IN THE ADOPTED PLAN AND MAP OF THE STREETS AND ALLEYS OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The Council, having made its own motion to vacate the herein-after described portion of Fir Street and Alley, situate in Block 17 of the City of Brookings, and having directed the giving of the notice of the vacation thereof as required by law and having held the public hearing called for in said notice, finds and hereby makes its determination a matter of record that the proceedings for the vacation of the said portion of said street and alley were had upon the Council's own motion and upon the petition of The Presbyterian Church of the City of Brookings and Palm M. Stout and C. A. Mc Kenzie, who own property adjacent to and which shall be affected by the said vacation of said street and alley, and, further, that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of the said portion of said street and alley; that the best interest and welfare of the public will be served by such vacation; and that said vacation should be affected.

SECTION 2. That portion of Fir Street, in the City of Brookings, Oregon, adjacent to the North line of Block 17, Brookings, as per Plat No. 1 of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, as approved December 1, 1920 and recorded in Book 1, page 5 of the official record of town plats and described as follows: beginning at the Northeast (NE) corner of said Block 17; thence North 21 deg. 50 min. West 40.0 feet; thence South 68 deg. 10 min. West 340.0 feet; thence South 7 deg. 48 min. East 41.23 feet to the Northwest (NW) corner of Lot 20, Block 17 aforesaid; thence following the North line of said Block 17 North 68 deg. 10 min. East 350.0 feet to the point of beginning, shall be, and hereby is, declared vacated absolutely, leaving the Public with no right or interest whatsoever therein and this said portion of said Fir Street, shall revert back to the abutting property owners, of said vacated portion, as provided by law.

SECTION 3. That portion of an unnamed alley, in the City of Brookings, Oregon, which extends Easterly and Westerly through Block 17, Brookings, as per Plat No. 1 of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, as approved December 1, 1920, and recorded in Book 1, page 5, of the official record of town plats and described as follows: beginning at the Northeast (NE) corner of Lot 13, Block 17 aforesaid; thence North 21 deg. 50 min. West 14.0 feet; thence South 68 deg.

10 min. West 350.0 feet to the Southwest (SW) corner of Lot 20; thence South 21 deg. 50 min. East 14.0 feet to the Northwest (NW) corner of lot 7; thence North 68 deg. 10 min. East 350.0 feet to the point of beginning, shall be, and hereby is, declared vacated absolutely, leaving the Public with no right or interest whatsoever therein and this said portion of said alley, shall revert back to the abutting property owners, of said vacated portion, as provided by law.

SECTION 4. The City Engineer shall prepare a map, and cause the same to be recorded with the City Recorder, showing thereon and setting forth therein, that portion of Fir Street and that portion of the unnamed alley hereby, in this ordinance, vacated.

SECTION 5. That portion of Fir Street and that portion of the unnamed alley in this ordinance vacated shall be excluded from the approved system and plan of streets and alleys of the City of Brookings and from the official map thereof and the said map shall be amended to show said exclusion.
