

ORDINANCE NO. 72.

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING CHAPTERS OF OREGON REVISED STATUTES AS THE LAW OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS; ADOPTING THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE BY REFERENCE; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF RULES, REGULATIONS, AND A SCHEDULE OF FEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. ADOPTION OF LAW BY REFERENCE. Chapters 479; 651; and 694, as the provisions thereof pertain to electrical wiring and equipment, are hereby declared to be the law covering electrical wiring and equipment within the corporate limits of the City of Brookings, Oregon, as if each of the the said Chapters of Oregon Revised Statutes were herein fully set forth.

SECTION 2. ADOPTION OF CODE BY REFERENCE. Pursuant to Section 479.420 Oregon Revised Statutes, the City of Brookings, Oregon, hereby adopts the National Electrical Code as approved by the American Standards Association. This adoption of the said Code shall take precedence over all prior ordinances of the City of Brookings and any and all ordinances, and the provisions thereof, to the extent that each and all of the same conflict with the said adoption of said Code are hereby repealed. The provisions of said Code hereadopted, insofar as they apply to the installation and operation of electrical wire, appliances, apparatus, and equipment, shall be in full force and effect as if said National Electric Code was herein fully set forth. It shall be the duty of the City Works Superintendent to obtain and keep on file in his office a copy of the 1953 National Electrical Code, together with all amendments thereto, as the same is approved by the American Standards Association.

SECTION 3. RULES, REGULATIONS, AND FEES. The City Works Superintendent shall prepare all necessary rules, regulations and schedule of fees for all necessary supervision and inspection required by, or growing out of, the provisions and sections of this ordinance. Before becoming effective all such rules, regulations, and fee schedules, so prepared and established by the City Works Superintendent shall be submitted to the Council, for its rejection or approval.

SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its publication.
