

ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, ON JULY 7, 1955, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, TO LEVY A TAX OF \$11,958.00 FOR THE PURPOSE OF BALANCING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1955-56, CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, WHICH TAX IS TO BE OUTSIDE THE LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN ARTICLE XI, SECTION 11, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF OREGON.

WHEREAS, the regularly appointed and acting budget committee of the City of Brookings has, in accordance with the provisions of the Local Budget Law (Paragraph ORS 294305 - 294415) as of date of May 11, 1955, prepared and adopted their budget for the City of Brookings for said fiscal year, this said budget and the estimates thereof having been approved on June 8, 1955, by the City Council, the levying board for the City of Brookings, Oregon, after a lawful hearing thereon having been held, and so having been adopted to the effect that in addition to the amount of \$29,250.00, there shall be raised by direct levy upon taxable property within the corporate limits of the City of Brookings the additional sum of \$11,958.00, which sum is outside the limitation on taxation set forth in Article XI, Section 11, Oregon Constitution and whereas it is necessary to submit the question of the levy of the said sum of \$11,958.00 outside the limitation on taxation aforesaid to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon,

NOW THEREFORE,

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, DOES ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The proposition set forth in Section 2 of this ordinance shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this ordinance to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, at a special city election to be held on July 7, 1955.

SECTION 2. At the aforesaid special election there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon,

for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"In the fiscal period of 1955-56 the Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, is authorized to levy a tax of \$11,958.00 for the purpose of balancing the budget for said fiscal period which tax is to be outside the limitation on taxation set forth in Article XI, Section 11, of the Constitution of Oregon."

SECTION 3. (1) The polling place for the aforesaid special election shall be in the Council Chambers of the City Hall of the City of Brookings, Oregon, and the polls for this special city election shall be open between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 8:00 o'clock P. M., of the date on which the said special election shall be held.

(2) The judges for the aforesaid election shall be

and the said judges and clerks shall hold their respective offices as so designated during the day of the said special election.

SECTION 4. Notice of the aforesaid special city election shall be given not earlier than twenty (20) days and not later than ten (10) days before the election. Said notice shall be issued under the seal of the City and shall be published in two (2) consecutive issues of the Brookings-Harbor Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Brookings, Oregon, and also be posted in five (5) public places in the City of Brookings, Oregon, including the City Hall. The notice published in the newspaper and posted in the said five (5) public places shall be in the following form:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on July 7, 1955, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock A. M. and 8:00 o'clock P. M. a special election shall be held within the corporate limits of the city of Brookings, Oregon, in the Council Chambers in the City Hall within

said City, upon the following proposition, to-wit:

In the fiscal period of 1955-56 the Council of the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon, is authorized to levy a tax of \$11,958.00 for the purpose of balancing the City Budget for said fiscal period, which tax is to be outside the limitations on taxation in Article XI, Section 11, Oregon Constitution.

This proposition, if adopted, will permit the Council of the City of Brookings, Oregon, to increase the 1955-56 tax levy in the sum of \$11,958.00 outside of the limitation on taxation in Article XI, Section 11, Oregon Constitution.

The boundary of the precincts in which the polling place aforesaid has been established will be the corporate limits of the City of Brookings.

SECTION 5. The notices of the aforesaid special city election herein required to be given shall constitute the only notices necessary and all ordinances or resolutions in conflict herewith shall not apply to the notices required to be given of this election. It shall be unnecessary for either the City of Brookings or any of the officials thereof to furnish to legal voters at the special city election pamphlets containing either (1) the text of the proposition or (2) arguments in support of or in opposition to the proposition.

SECTION 6. The following is the number and form in which the question shall be printed on the official ballot.

SECTION 7. The City Recorder shall provide for the printing of the official ballot provided for hereinabove in Section 6, and provide for the proper distribution thereof and shall provide and furnish to the polling places and judges and clerks of election, herein before named, all necessary materials as the same may be required in said polling place and by said judges and clerks and so be necessary in the holding of this special city election.


