

ORDINANCE NO. 76 .

AN ORDINANCE DIRECTING AND EMPOWERING THE MAYOR, TOGETHER WITH THE RECORDER, OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS TO APPLY TO THE STATE OF OREGON FOR A PERMIT TO APPROPRIATE PUBLIC WATERS OF THE STATE OF OREGON, FROM THE CHEWCO RIVER, FOR THE USE OF THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. The term "Permit" as hereinafter used in this ordinance shall mean that permit applied for in an application to the State of Oregon, by and through its State Engineer, to appropriate certain Public Waters of the State of Oregon for use as a Municipal Water Supply by the City of Brookings, Oregon, a copy of said application being attached to this ordinance and by such reference made a part of this ordinance.


SECTION 2. It is hereby declared that it is the intention of the City Council, upon behalf of the City of Brookings, to enter into and be bound by the agreements, provisions and conditions set forth and included in the written application for said permit.

SECTION 3. It shall be the duty of the Mayor, together with the City Recorder, to execute said application for said permit as of August 23, 1955, and the Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and empowered so to execute said application for said permit, and, further, by said execution to bind the City of Brookings to each and all of the agreements, provisions and conditions contained and set forth in said application for permit and in the copy thereof which is attached to and made a part of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
