

ORDINANCE NO. 87

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR A FORM OF AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, OREGON, AND THE STATE OF OREGON ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS STATE HIGHWAY COMMISSION, FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF PIONEER ROAD FROM PACIFIC AVENUE TO EASY STREET AND FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF EASY STREET FROM PIONEER ROAD WESTERLY FOR APPROXIMATELY 335 FEET, IN ALL A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY 0.20 MILE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The City of Brookings does ordain as follows:

WHEREAS the City of Brookings has heretofore made an application to the State of Oregon, through its Highway Commission, for assistance in repair or reconstructing under the provisions of 366,800 and 366,805 O R S, and

WHEREAS the State Highway Commission has accepted said application for the improvement of Pioneer Road from Pacific Avenue to Easy Street and Easy Street from Pioneer Road westerly for approximately 335 feet, a distance of 0.20 mile, and ~~x~~

WHEREAS in the form of an agreement prepared by the State Highway Commission, a copy whereof marked "Exhibit A" is attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, the State Highway Commission has agreed to pay the cost of the project up to \$15,000.00 and the City of Brookings to pay all cost in excess of \$15,000.00 and

WHEREAS it is necessary that said improvement be made in the Spring and Summer of 1956 and, to such effect, the State Highway Commission can not award a contract for said improvement until the aforesaid agreement "Exhibit A" has been executed by the City of Brookings, now therefore:

SECTION 1. The aforesaid agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit A, by and between the City of Brookings and the State of Oregon acting by and through its Highway Commission, is hereby approved and accepted as submitted and set forth in this ordinance No. 87.

SECTION 2. The Mayor and Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement as set forth herein as Exhibit A in triplicate and after executing the same to deliver the same to the State Highway Commission of the State of Oregon for execution by said Commission.

SECTION 3. It is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings, Oregon, and that ~~an~~ an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
