

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 12A OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, ADOPTED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR ON THE 29th DAY OF July, 1952, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Ordinance No. 12A, adopted by the Council and approved by the Mayor on the 29th day of July, 1952, is hereby amended by the addition of the following sections to said ordinance:

Section 20: In addition to the coin-operated music boxes licensed by this ordinance, all other machines, devices and equipment which are operated or supplied, distributed or maintained for operation within the City of Brookings shall be licensed in accordance with the following schedule of fees:

"1. Pinball machines, \$60.00 per year, for each machine.

"2. All mechanical bowling, baseball, hockey, basketball, shuffleboard, skill pool and other amusement devices not herein specifically mentioned, \$15.00 per year, "for each machine."

Section 21: All provisions of this ordinance relative to coin-operated music boxes are hereby extended to and applied to the machines mentioned in Section 20."

Section 22: It shall be unlawful for any person to make any false statement in any application for any license issued under this ordinance, regardless of the materiality thereof."

Section 23: The licensing provisions of this ordinance shall cover the period beginning January 1, 1957, and each calendar year thereafter."

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable that any question as to the license fees to be charged by the City of Brookings should be settled and determined without delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and morals of the City of Brookings and the

inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon its final passage at any one meeting of the Council.
