

ORDINANCE NO. 110

AN ORDINANCE CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION IN THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, CURRY COUNTY, OREGON, TO BE HELD ON THE 7TH DAY OF JANUARY, 1958, SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY AT SAID SPECIAL ELECTION A PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT OF THE CHARTER OF SAID CITY OF BROOKINGS AMENDING THE CHARTER BY ADDING THERETO A NEW AND ADDITIONAL CHAPTER TO BE KNOWN AS CHAPTER XI, AS PROVIDED BY RESOLUTION NO. 31 AS HERETOFORE ADOPTED, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAENS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Resolution No. 31, heretofore adopted by the Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Brookings, Oregon, on December 10, 1957 shall be filed forthwith with the City Recorder and the Charter amendment proposed by Resolution No. 31 shall be submitted to the legal voters of said City of Brookings at said special city election hereinafter called for that purpose.

Section 2: A special city election of the City of Brookings, Oregon is hereby called to be held in the City of Brookings, Curry County, Oregon on the 7th day of January, 1958. The polls for the receipt of the ballots in said special election shall be opened at 8 o'clock in the morning and shall be kept open until 8 o'clock in the evening of said day. One polling place shall be established in each of the voting precincts of the City of Brookings in the following places:

Precinct No. 1	I.O.O.F. Hall, 547 Hemlock Street.
Precinct No. 2	V.F.W. Hall, 507 Pacific Street.
Precinct No. 3	Northgate Building, 1109 Chetco Avenue.

The Council shall, by resolution hereafter, designate the Judges ~~Clarks~~ ~~Clerks~~ of said election to serve in each of the respective precincts.

Section 3: The ballot title for such proposed Charter amendment to be so submitted to the legal voters as aforesaid as heretofore adopted by the Council by said Resolution No. 31 and as now adopted and affirmed by the Council and as the same shall appear on the ballot at said special election is as follows:

CITY OF BROOKINGS BOND AMENDMENT

AN ACT

To amend the Charter of the City of Brookings, Oregon, by adding thereto Chapter XI authorizing the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$150,000.00 in bonds of said City to provide funds with which to acquire, construct and provide a sewage disposal plant for said City, together with intercepting sewers, out-fall sewers, a pumping station, pressure line and equipment necessary, together with the construction of a city warehouse, providing that the debt limitation of said Charter shall not apply to said bonds, providing for the repayment of principal and interest of said bonds from taxes and authorizing the City to secure federal aid, loans or grants to pay a part of the cost of such sewage disposal plant, all for the City of Brookings.

Section 4: The form of the official ballot for use in said special election and in which form said ballot shall be printed shall be substantially as follows:

Those voting in favor of the amendment and the issuance of the bonds shall mark their ballots with an X YES.

Those voting against the amendment and the issuance of the bonds shall mark their ballots with an X NO.

CITY OF BROOKINGS BOND AMENDMENT

A Charter amendment submitted and referred to the legal voters of the City of Brookings, Oregon, by the Council of said City.

AN ACT

To amend the Charter of the City of Brookings, Oregon, by adding thereto Chapter XI authorizing the issuance and sale of not to exceed \$150,000.00 in bonds of said City to provide funds with which to acquire, construct and provide a sewage disposal plant for said City, together with intercepting sewers, out-fall sewers, a pumping station, pressure line and equipment necessary, together with the construction of a city warehouse, providing that the debt limitation of said Charter shall not apply to said bonds, providing for the repayment of principal and interest to said bonds from taxes, and authorizing the City to secure federal aid, loans or grants to pay a part of the cost of such sewage disposal plant, all for the City of Brookings.

Section 5: The City Recorder shall post and publish notice of said special election within the City, as provided in this ordinance. This notice shall be given over the signature of the City Recorder. Notice shall be posted at least ten (10) days before said election in a conspicuous place in the City Hall of Brookings and in three public places in each voting precinct in the City of Brookings. The notice shall also be published in two (2) consecutive issues of the Brookings-Harbor Pilot, a newspaper of general circulation published weekly in the City of Brookings. The publication shall be once each week

for two weeks immediately preceding the election. The notice so posted and published shall be in the following form:

NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that, pursuant to Resolution No. 31 and Ordinance No. 110 adopted and passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor of the City of Brookings on December 10, 1957, a Charter amendment providing for the issuance of not to exceed \$150,000.00 in bonds will be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Brookings at a special city election to be held on January 7, 1958. The ballot title, number of the proposed Charter amendment and bond issue is as follows:

CITY OF BROOKINGS BOND AMENDMENT

AN ACT

Section 6: The City Recorder is hereby instructed to notify the Clerks when the same shall have been appointed to act as Clerks at said special city election and to prepare and cause to be printed and furnished the proper ballots for use in said special city election and deliver said ballots and ballot boxes to the said election officials, and to do any and all things necessary to be done to provide for the proper calling and holding of said election.

Section 7: The result of the election shall be certified by the Clerks of the election to the City Recorder and the Clerks of said election, immediately after canvassing the votes and before they separate and adjourn, shall enclose the poll books in separate covers and securely seal the same. They shall enclose the tally sheets in separate envelopes and seal the same securely. They shall also enclose the ballots and stubs, strung on strings, and seal all of the same securely. They shall in writing with pen and ink specify the contents and address each of said packages

upon the outside thereof and immediately deliver the same to the City Recorder of the City of Brookings.

Section 8: The notice of this election as herein required to be given by the City Recorder shall be the only notice given and the manner of holding and conducting this special election shall be as specified and provided in this ordinance, notwithstanding the provisions of any resolution or ordinance, or both, of the City of Brookings in conflict therewith and the same shall not apply to the requirements or notices for this special election. It shall be unnecessary for either the City of Brookings or any officials thereof to furnish the legal voters of said City with election pamphlets or otherwise containing either the text or the proposition to be voted upon or arguments in support of or in opposition to the proposition.

Section 9: Whereas, it is necessary and essential to the peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and the inhabitants thereof that proper and adequate sewage disposal system be provided for the City as soon as possible and that the money be provided therefor through the sale of bonds to be authorized by the election herein called, and it is necessary and desirable that a special city election be called as soon as possible for the purpose of submitting said bond issue to the legal voters, an emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings and its inhabitants, and this ordinance may be introduced and placed upon its final passage at any one meeting of the Council and shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
