

ORDINANCE NO. 111

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTION 6 OF ORDINANCE NO. 6 OF THE CITY OF BROOKINGS, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCES NO. 80 and 103 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF BROOKINGS ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 6 of Ordinance No. 6 of the City of Brookings, as amended by Ordinance No. 80 of the City of Brookings passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on December 13, 1955, and as further amended by Ordinance No. 103 of the City of Brookings passed by the Council and approved by the Mayor on December 18, 1956, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 6: ANNUAL FEES. There is hereby levied and imposed upon each business in the City of Brookings a license tax for such business as herein provided. The license tax for each such business for the six months period beginning January 1, 1958 and terminating June 30, 1958, and for any part thereof of more than one month, shall be the sum of \$12.50. The license tax for each such business for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1958 and terminating June 30, 1959 and for each such fiscal year thereafter shall be the sum of \$25.00. If the license tax for a full fiscal year is paid on or before the 1st day of August, a discount of 10% in the license fee shall be allowed and granted. If the full licensed tax has not been paid by August 31, the \$25.00 license tax plus 10% shall be paid. The payment of the tax and the issuance of a license for the conduct of any business prohibited by law or ordinance of the City of Brookings shall not be deemed to be a permit or license of the City of Brookings for the conduct of any such business or to waive any provision of law or ordinance now or hereafter enacted regulating or prohibiting the conduct of any such business, or a part thereof. In the event the City of

Brookings shall be prevented or prohibited by law from licensing and taxing any business, this ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect as to all other businesses or branches of businesses provided to be licensed. Any such prohibition or prevention now or hereafter in effect shall not affect the validity of this ordinance as to any other business."

Section 2: An emergency is hereby declared to exist in the interest of the public peace, health and safety of the City of Brookings, and the inhabitants thereof, and this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage at any one meeting of the Council.
