

RESOLUTION NO. CXXIV (234)

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby Budget for the 1977-78 fiscal tax year was approved by the voters of said City at a Budget and Tax Levy Election on June 22, 1977; and

WHEREAS, a Supplemental Budget was adopted by the Canby City Council after public hearing on August 3, 1977; and

WHEREAS, the City has now received State revenue sharing for the current fiscal year and a Second Supplemental Budget is required for the necessary expenditures; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on this proposed (Second) Supplemental Budget and the expenditures as indicated hereunder was duly and regularly called and held in and for the City of Canby at 8:00 o'clock p.m. on Wednesday, November 16, 1977, at the Council Chambers at the Canby City Hall after proper notice of such hearing was first given in the manner and for the time required by law; and

WHEREAS, the proposed (Second) Supplemental Budget and expenditure of funds as indicated hereunder was considered by the Council and publicly discussed, and there were no objections or remonstrances; now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED that:

Section 1: The following SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET for the City of Canby for the 1977-78 fiscal tax year is hereby adopted and the resources as shown are hereby appropriated for expenditure for the purposes as shown in the SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL BUDGET.
