RESOLUTION NO. CCXLVI (246)

A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT JURISDICTION OF SOUTHWEST 13th AVENUE AND REQUESTING FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION FROM CLACKAMAS COUNTY FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, CLACKAMAS COUNTY has jurisdiction of Southwest 13th Avenue (County Road No. 1494), being approximately 2,115 feet in length, lying between South Ivy Street and South Elm Street, within the city limits of Canby; and,

WHEREAS, during recent discussions between City and County Public Works officials, indication was made to the City that the County would participate to the extent of \$25,048.65 to improve said street to City of Canby standards; and,

WHEREAS, it has been the usual procedure for the City of Canby to request jurisdiction of portions of county roads in recognition of the county's substantial participation in the improvement of such portions of county roads; and,

WHEREAS, CLACKAMAS COUNTY has made the City acceptance of 13th Avenue as above described, the basis of the County offer of financial participation;

NOW, THEREFORE;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of Canby requests jurisdiction of the above described county road from Clackamas County and petitions the county to set a hearing date for said transfer and do all things necessary as required by law; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council of Canby requests financial participation in the improvement of said 13th Avenue in the amount of \$25,048.65 in recognition of the acceptance of jurisdiction of 13th Avenue as above described.
