RESOLUTION NO. CCL (250)

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF CANBY, CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON, ON THE 27TH DAY OF OCTOBER, 1978, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY THE QUESTION OF A GENERAL OBLIGATION BOND ISSUE FOR WATER PURPOSES.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Canby, Clackamas County, State of Oregon, call a Special City Election to be held at the Canby City Hall in said City on Friday, the 27th day of October, 1978, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Saving Time, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of said City, pursuant to the Canby City Charter and the City's Initiative and Referendum Ordinance No. 380, the question of contracting a general obligation bonded indebtedness in the name of the City in the sum of THREE MILLION DOLLARS (\$3,000,000) for a term not exceeding twenty (20) years for the purpose of providing funds with which to make additions, extensions and improvements to the water supply and distribution systems; construct, equip and develop another source of water and water supply facilities; and acquire necessary land and rights-of-way therefor, in and for the City of Canby.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clackamas County Elections Department conduct said Election and it is hereby requested to do so in accordance with the general Election Laws of the State of Oregon; and that upon the conclusion of said Election, it certify the results thereof to the Canby City Council.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following is the ballot title and form in which the proposed bond issue shall be printed and submitted on the Official Ballot, except that the ballot number may be changed in order to conform to the County Elections Department numbering method for a punch-card ballot.

BOND ISSUE PROPOSED BY COMMON COUNCIL

Shall the City of Canby contract a general obligation bonded indebtedness in the sum of \$3,000,000 for a term not exceeding twenty (20) years for the purpose of providing funds with which to make additions, extensions and improvements to the water supply and distribution systems; construct, equip and develop another source of water and water supply facilities; and acquire necessary land and rights-of-way therefor, in and for the City of Canby?

The voter shall place a cross (X) or a check (\checkmark) in the box between the number and answer voted for or punch the appropriate answer if a punch-card ballot is used, to signify the choice. VOTE YES OR NO.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Recorder be and she hereby is directed to prepare and publish a Notice of said election by posting a Notice in six (6) public and conspicuous places within the City and also at the Canby City Hall which is the only polling place at least ten (10) days prior to said election, and also publish the said Notice in the Canby Herald, a newspaper of general circulation in said City for two successive weeks, the first publication of such notice to be not less than fifteen (15) days, preceding the date of the election. The Election Notice to be posted and published shall be in substantially the following form:

On Friday, October 27, 1978, between the hours of 8:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m., Oregon Daylight Savings time, a Special City Election will be held at the Canby City Hall in and for the City of Canby, Clackamas County, Oregon for the purpose of submitting to the qualified legal voters of the City of Canby the question of contracting a general obligation bonded indebtedness in the name of the City in the sum of \$3,000,000 for a term not exceeding twenty (20) years for the purpose of providing funds with which to make additions, extensions and improvements to the water supply and distribution systems; construct, equip and develop another source of water and water supply facilities; and acquire necessary land and rights-of-way therefor, in and for the City of Canby. The ballot title and form in which the proposed bond issue shall be printed and submitted on the official ballot is is as follows:
