

RESOLUTION NO. CCLIV (254)

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING JURISDICTION OVER A PORTION  
OF SOUTHWEST 13TH AVENUE, COUNTY ROAD NO. 1494

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Clackamas County, Oregon, accepted the City's request for jurisdiction over a portion of Southwest 13th Avenue, County Road No. 1494, and made its Order No. 78-2063 on November 2, 1978, transferring jurisdiction over a portion of said road as described in said Order, but on the condition that the City's acceptance of jurisdiction must be made to the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners within ninety (90) days from the date of such order; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council initiated this matter by its Resolution No. CCXLVI (246) which was adopted on September 6, 1978, and entitled "A RESOLUTION TO ACCEPT JURISDICTION OF SOUTHWEST 13th AVENUE AND REQUESTING FINANCIAL PARTICIPATION FROM CLACKAMAS COUNTY FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS"; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council desires to complete this matter and is willing to accept jurisdiction over that portion of Southwest 13th Avenue, County Road No. 1494, as described in said Order of the Board of County Commissioners; now, therefore, it is hereby

RESOLVED that the Canby City Council hereby accepts from the Clackamas County Board of Commissioners jurisdiction over the following described road, to-wit:

That portion of Southwest 13th Avenue, County Road No. 1494, located in Section 4, T. 4 S., R. 1 E. of the W.M. being approximately 2,115 feet in length lying between South Ivy Street and Elm Street within the city limits of Canby.
