

RESOLUTION NO. CCLVII (257)

A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING PARKING ON HIGHWAY 99E

WHEREAS, increased traffic flow on Highway 99E has caused an increase in traffic accidents on the Highway within the city limits of Canby; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Police have recommended that a continuous left turn lane be placed in the middle of Highway 99E; and

WHEREAS, it will be necessary to restrict parking on Highway 99E to provide ample room for a left turn refuge lane; and

WHEREAS, sixty-five (65) resident property owners were contacted concerning the proposed change to restrict parking within the corporate limits of the City of Canby on Highway 99E and only one resident voiced any objection; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Administrator was delegated the authority to direct the installation, maintenance, change, or removal of official signs, signals and markers in the City of Canby pursuant to Resolution No. CLXXVII (177); however, the Oregon State Highway Division has declared that it would restripe and place the appropriate signs on Highway 99E only after the governing body of the City of Canby officially restricted parking on Highway 99E.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Canby City Council that parking is hereby prohibited on both sides of Highway 99E within the corporate city limits of the City of Canby.

Adopted by the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, January 3, 1979.
